The kickass-pirational pop musical, *Fantastically Great Women Who Changed the World*, is heading to Edinburgh Festival Fringe 2022, following a hugely successful UK tour. This empowering stage show, based on the popular children's book by Suffragette descendant Kate Pankhurst, and adapted by Chris Bush (*Faustus: That Damned Woman*, Headlong; *Pericles*, National Theatre; *The Band Plays On*, Sheffield Theatres), comes from one of the producers of international hit musical *SIX*.

Featuring catchy original songs by hit songwriter Miranda Cooper (Girls Aloud; Sugababes; Kylie Minogue) and Jennifer Decilveo (Miley Cyrus; Ben Platt), *Fantastically Great Women Who Changed the World* follows young heroine Jade on a school trip where she meets impressive historical women in the Gallery of Greatness. Celebrated – and often forgotten – female stories are brought to life on stage, including those of Rosa Parks, Sacagawea, Amelia Earhart, Marie Curie, Mary Seacole, Frida Kahlo, Jane Austen, and Pankhurst's own relative Emmeline. This uplifting, feel-good musical is full of remarkable stories, surprising lessons and a toe-tapping soundtrack played by a live band that packs a popstar punch.

Playing these brilliant women is a talented all-female cast including two original *SIX* queens: **Renée Lamb** (*SIX*, West End; *Be More Chill*, The Other Palace and Shaftesbury Theatre; *Little Shop of Horrors*, Regent's Park Open Air Theatre), **Christina Modestou** (*SIX*, West End; *We Will Rock You*, Dominion Theatre; *In The Heights*, Southwark Playhouse), **Jade Kennedy** (*The Snow Queen*, Brighton Open Air Theatre; *Billy Elliot*, Victoria Palace Theatre), **Kirstie Skivington** (Everybody's Talking About Jamie, Apollo Theatre and The Crucible Sheffield; Jesus Christ Superstar, Regent's Park Open Air Theatre; Bend It Like Beckham, Phoenix Theatre), Kudzai Mangombe (Malindadzimu, Hampstead Theatre), Elise Zavou (Red Riding Hood, Theatre Royal Stratford East) and Clarice Julianda (Priscilla: Queen of the Desert, UK tour).

Producer Kenny Wax comments, *We're thrilled to be taking* Fantastically Great Women Who Changed the World *to Edinburgh Fringe following on from its run in London at Theatre Royal Stratford East. We have been developing this new show for 7 years, even before we came across a certain new musical called* SIX, *which had its breakthrough season at the Edinburgh Festival. As a company we are excited to continue our work celebrating extraordinary women from history.*
