The show used to be largely written by a team of off-site writers all over the country but is now written by the company members with a variety of former performers and directors being hired as a 'Writer in the Room' providing first-hand experience of how to react to the fast-paced changing headlines.

The amazing cast are accompanied by on-stage Musical Director Richard Baker (*Peter Pan Goes Wrong* - composer/musical director) who ensures the music gives us a night to remember.

Director Charlie Ryall comments, NewsRevue has been an institution for years and what makes it exciting is its eternal relevancy. The changing face of comedy over the last decade, and the way in which the public consumes media, means that freshness is more necessary than ever, and the team at NewsRevue is always looking to not only adapt to the changing landscape, but to drive it. Working on this show is always such a pleasure; the talent on stage and behind the scenes really must be seen to be believed. Now, more than ever, we as a nation need to find ways to see the light at the end of the tunnel, and if NewsRevue can help to hold the torch, then we're doing our bit.
